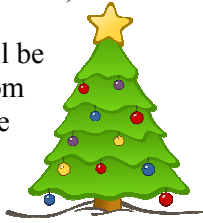
Gateway Arena- Preschool skates- Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday 11:00am-12:00pm.
