will require a permit. Examples: Adding  
a deck, a pool, a storage building or  
anything else, call the office to see if it  
requires a permit. If you start  
construction or move a building to your  
property without one, you can be charged  
double for the permit, or worse for  
example, made to move it in order to  
comply with regulations, so check first!

Office. The cost is \$10.00 per dog per  
year. Thanks!
