### **Town of Borden-Carleton** **Public Notices**

**RCMP-**Council is hearing there are concerns in regards to some policing matters in the Town. We have set up an anonymous police complaints box in the office, as well as made a time slot on the second Wednesday of every month from 1:00pm-3:00pm in case you would like to personally meet with an RCMP officer.

**Building/Moving Permit** Just a reminder to residents, if you are changing structures on your property you will require a permit. Examples: Adding a deck, a pool, a storage building or anything else, call the office to see if it requires a permit. If you start construction or move a building to your property without one, you can be charged double for the permit, or worse for example, made to move it in order to comply with regulations, so check first!

### **No Overnight Street Parking**

Starting December 1st until April 30th, no motor vehicle shall be parked, or left on the street overnight with-in the Town of Borden-Carleton between the hours of 12:01am and 8am.

**Leaving your vehicle parked on the street over night could result in you being towed at your expense!!**
