Municipal Election Call for Nominations

Residents of the Town of Borden-Carleton are hereby given notice that a municipal election will be held on Monday, November 5th 2018.

Procedures for nominations:

1. Nomination papers may be obtained from the Town office, 20 Dickie Road, Borden-Carleton, PE, C0B 1X0;
2. Every candidate for the office of Mayor or Councillor must be nominated in writing by at least five electors.
3. Nomination Papers must be delivered to the **Town office** before 2:00 p.m., Friday, October 19, 2018. A \$10.00 fee is payable to the Chief Administrative Officer of the Town at the time of nomination, which is refundable to any candidate who receives one-half or more of the votes cast for the candidate elected

With the election a few months away I would like to highlight a few dates:

October 10th - Nomination Papers available

October 19th - Nominations Closed 2pm

October 27th - Advance Poll (9am-7pm)

November 5th - Voting day (9am-7pm)

RCMP- Council have been hearing there are concerns in regards to some policing matters in the Town. We have set up an anonymous police complaints box in the office, as well as made a time slot on the second Wednesday of every month from 1-3pm in case you would like to personally meet with an RCMP officer. This month it will be September 12th.

Building/Moving Permit Just a reminder to residents, if you are changing structures on your property you will require a permit. Examples: Adding a deck, a pool, a storage building or anything else, call the office to see if it requires a permit. If you start construction or move a building to your property without one, you can be charged double for the permit, or worse, for example, made to move it in order to comply with regulations, so check first!
