Building/Moving Permit Just a reminder to residents, if you are changing structures on your property you will require a permit. Examples: Adding a deck, a pool, a storage building or anything else, call the office to see if it requires a permit. If you start construction or move a building to your property without one, you can be charged double for the permit, or worse for example, made to move it in order to comply with regulations, so check first!

Pools- please note that if you are considering installing a swimming pool in your yard that a permit is required, and please check the Borden-Carleton Zoning and Development Bylaw for the requirements for a pool installation (the bylaw is available on the town website and at the town office)
